## PK's Points "A Season of Renewal"

Retreats (Patmos/Skyview)

Retreats offer a wonderful opportunity to get away from the monotony of life, remove yourself from distractions, and make sure that you are in proper spiritual alignment. They are usually short in length and yet we all know that it is hard to get away from the ongoing responsibilities and deadlines that are often pressing upon us. So when you are able to get to a retreat, you definitely want it to be time-well-spent. But retreats are like most things, that you, personally, must make the most out of them. For each of us has a responsibility to go hungering to hear a word from the Lord through His Word that will refresh our spiritual batteries. Would you pray for the Fall Retreat season of Patmos and Skyview? Maybe you ought to consider attending, as, perhaps, you are needing some spiritual renewal. Would you pray for Pastor Kevin and Heather as they speak at Camp Patmos' Men's Retreat and Skyview's Ladies' Retreat, respectively? That's right, Pastor Kevin will be speaking at Camp Patmos Men's Retreat on September 4-6. 4 messages beginning Thursday evening and concluding Saturday around 1pm. Heather will be speaking at Skyview's Ladies' Retreat on October 3-4. 3 sessions beginning Friday evening and concluding Saturday night/Sunday early b-fast. Pray for their preparation, as well as, that as His Word is shared through them that hearts would be renewed with a desire to return home and serve the Lord with passion. Any are welcome to register and join us as retreats are best with friends.

#### Resources

I am excited to introduce a number of new resources to Hillside this Fall. My goal is that it will help equip us to counsel ourselves or be able to speak Biblical perspective into the lives of others that we interact with in life. The Christian Counseling & Educational Foundation (CCEF) puts out small booklets on a vast ray of subjects that enable us to think Biblically about topics that our world is facing today. I want to make these booklets available to us, as I believe they will enhance our Biblical worldview in areas that often do not get public attention, either due its uniqueness or sensitivity. The topics include anything to marital or parenting or family matters to personal matters. Topics may include helping people, think Biblically, through Bipolar Disorder or PTSD or how to speak to your children about LGBTQ matters or Cutting or even just Anxiety. These booklets are about \$5/per, and I want to include them in our Discipleship budget, but if you benefit from them, consider adding an amount to your giving to help offset the cost of them.
