Shoeboxes due November 23rd



How to Pack Your Shoebox:

- 1. **Find a Shoebox:** Get a standard-size shoebox to pack for a boy or girl. *Feel free to use the pre-printed boxes in the coffee room at the church.*
- 2. Get your Label: Determine whether you want to pack a box for a boy or girl and which age.
- 3. **Fill with Gifts:** First, select a quality "wow" toy such as a soccer ball with pump or stuffed animal then fill with other fun toys, hygiene items, and school supplies. Don't forget to also include a personal note and photo—sometimes these are the child's favorite things to receive!
- 4. **Pray:** Most importantly, pray for the child who will receive your shoebox gift. Include a personal note and photo to delight the heart of the child if you would like.
- 5. **Donate \$10 per Shoebox:** A donation of \$10 is critical to cover shipping and other project costs. Give online through Follow Your Box and discover the destination of your shoebox or send a check in the postage-paid envelope provided on the brochure.
- 6. **Drop off**: Place your shoebox at Hillside in the coffee room by Sunday, November 24th.

<u>Do NOT include</u>: candy; toothpaste; gum; used or damaged items; scary or war-related items; seeds; food; drink mixes; liquids or lotions; medications or vitamins; breakable items or glass containers; aerosol cans. **Information received from Samaritan's Purse.*

Rittman Christmas Baskets
